- 2016: Liberty Fund President and Chief Executive Officer
- 2020: Liberty Fund Senior Vice President and Pierre F. Goodrich Resident Scholar


















Pierre F. Goodrich and Liberty Fund, 1960

- Liberty Fund similar to Mont Pelerin Society in not having an agenda
- A forum, not a parade
- But with a mission: 'to enrich the understanding and appreciation of the complex nature of a society of free and responsible individuals'
- Leaving policy making and advocacy to other think tanks
- Socratic seminars: questions and arguments, not final answers
- Books in the conservative-liberal tradition
